

III ) - As soon as the system makes choices these are driven by the multiple re-discoveries of the advantages felt by him/her of choosing the « better » for him/her or the « good » for him/her. These felt advantages are able phylogenetically and ontologically to cumulate in how life is responsible in some part of his evolution.

IV ) - To support these hypothesis let me formulate the following proposition and clause :

Life experiments nature by discovering and re-discovering the Cooperation Principle ( CP ) which ~~is~~ or primitive shape is « union make strength » as the quantitativ most simple calculus/process of adding ( + operation ) ; id est when I add one to one I build two which is greater than one. In a more general but as fundamental Idea of it the Cooperation Principle is the gathering of elements as an accretion dynamic just logically conceivable according to the organisationnal power of the different processes generated by the feeling of « goals » and next the « goals' problematics ».

Note : I must drive here your attention on the following fact :

It seems that « goals processes » are strong ways/manners of articulating sensory / sensitiv / sensual modalities of life with logical / reflexive / responsible ones !

V ) - This Cooperation could only self extend because of assimilation steps of research of « better » as fixing a goal ( then under-goals ). This is thought of as proving by acts - and justifying - the power of realizing - or carrying into effects - the Cooperation Principle.

Mind this please : what would it logically means than a cooperation not organised by some process of aiming a target or the self organisation of a set by goal(s) this set becoming thus a system.

Because even if cooperating parts don't share the same feeling mixed with more or less logical apprehension of the goal they do share a minimal logically and sensitively felt understanding of this goal as organising or being able to federate the organisation ordering and governing this cooperation.
